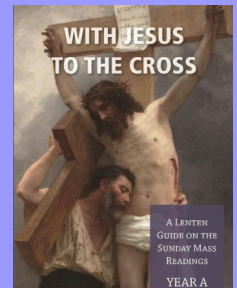

Opportunities for Prayer and Reflection

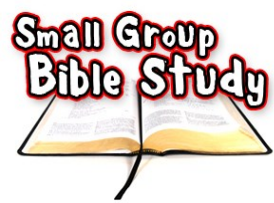
Connection to Christ















