

Fr. Don Senior, President Emeritus, Chancellor, Professor of New Testament Studies at Catholic Theological Union will speak at Sheil about Pope Francis and the Christian response to the Ecological Crisis, Thursday, May 4 at 7:00 p.m. All community members are welcome.

Fr. Senior served as President of CTU for 23 years, retiring in July 2013. On April 27, 2015, he was named Chancellor by the CTU Board of Trustees.

He is also an author of multiple books, a frequent lecturer across the country, and recently a visiting professor of scripture studies at Northwestern University.
