Imam Abdul Malik Mujahid is an award winning author and producer with a focus on contemporary social issues, public policy and Islam-West relations.

He was selected six times as one of the 500 most influential Muslims in the world in 2011-2016.

Imam Mujahid chairs the Burma Task Force USA to stop the genocide of Rohingyas in Burma. In the past he led efforts to help Muslims in Mali and Central African Republic. As the national coordinator of the Bosnia Task Force, USA, he successfully led efforts to declare rape as a war crime.

He is president of Sound Vision and has authored more than 400 articles on Islamic living and public policy. He is a blogger at Huffington Post and his book on political sociology was the winner of an Outstanding Academic Book of the Year Award by American Library Association in 1990.
